Sport's Diplomatic Role

Sport has historically played an influential role in international affairs and diplomacy. From the truce called during the Ancient Olympics to the exclusion of Apartheid South Africa from international competitions, its impact has been significant. Recent events demonstrate that major sporting events can uniquely contribute to geopolitical dynamics, societal changes, economic development, and global challenges.

The Initiative

Sport Diplomacy Dialogues is a joint initiative of the Permanent Secretariat of the World Summit of Nobel Laureates for Peace and Save the Dream dedicated to the role of sport in promoting and restoring peace and reconciliation. Sport Diplomacy Dialogues is an integral element of the World Summit of Nobel Laureates for Peace, taking the form of high-level conversations among Nobel Peace Laureates, leaders in sport, international affairs, and influential athletes.

The Goals

- Provide a multi-sectoral environment for **discussing and addressing international issues through sport** and boosting related diplomatic efforts.
- **Promote international instruments and instigate collective actions** to prevent, mitigate, or resolve conflicts using the most popular sports.
- Foster a common agenda regarding the role of sport in driving positive change and promote resource mobilization in support of such a process.
- Identify **outstanding projects and achievements in the field of "sport diplomacy"** and support new initiatives.
- Empower athletes at all levels as role models and peace advocates.

First Edition 2024: Unveiling the Vision

September 19th, 2024, is the date of the first edition of the Sport Diplomacy Dialogues, taking place on the occasion of the **XIX Edition of the World Summit of Nobel Laureates for Peace**, this latter hosted in Monterrey from the 18th to the 21st of September by the Permanent Secretariat jointly with the World Meeting of Values and the Government of Nuevo Leon.
